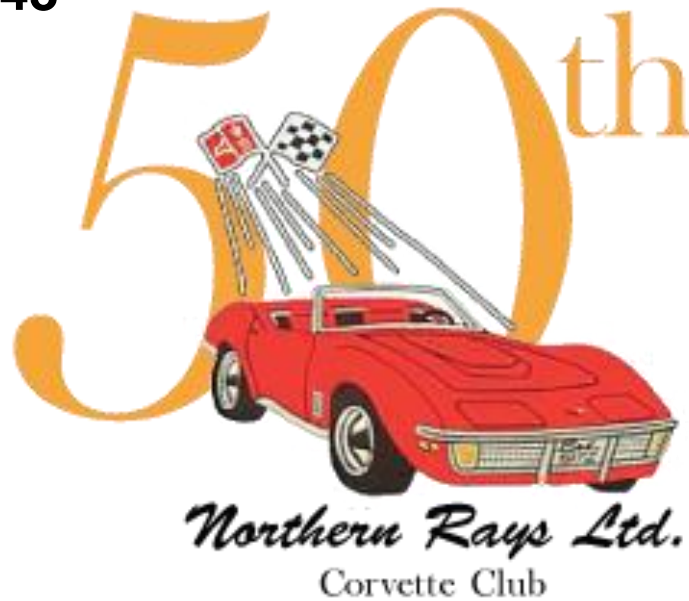

What will be voted on at the May 6th meeting will be which procedure will be used.

ALSO: If you are competing in the speed at convention in Bowling Green, you should have received the General Instructions via email for both the High Speed and/or Low Speed events. Those Generals contain the mandatory information you will need prior to the events. It will tell you what time to be there and dos and don't for the track.

There is a really big group competing in both events so it is important for you to be at the event on time based on the information in the Generals. If you did not get them, please contact Jack Alexander at [cptjac@msn.com](mailto:cptjac@msn.com).

I am looking forward to being back in Bowling Green for another convention. There is a new Trolley that stops at the NCM Thursday through Saturday.
