Duties of an Elected Officer

ARTICLE V

Section 1. Duties of an Officer

In addition to performing the designated function of his office, a member of the Board of Officers is entrusted with the responsibility of establishing Club policy, upholding the bylaws of the Club, carrying out the purpose of the Club, and, above all, acting in the best interest of the Club and its individual members. It is also their duty to attend Club meetings and functions.

Section 2. Duties of the President

The President shall be the Chief Executive of the Club. The President shall preside at all meetings of the members and shall have the responsibility for the general control and management of all Club activities. He is responsible for the care and custody of all Club property and shall maintain an up-to-date record of all such property, which shall include the name of any member charged with temporary custody thereof. He may call special meetings under the provisions of Article III. He shall be an ex-officio member of all committees and preside at the Board of Officers meeting in the absence of the Vice President. Other responsibilities include regular communication with the other officers and committee chairmen to ensure coordination of functions and successful completion of activities. He shall appoint a parliamentarian and web master on a yearly basis or as necessary. (amended 2/23/2002 and 7/11/2023)

Section 3. <u>Duties of the Vice President</u>

In the absence of the President or in case of his death, resignation or inability to act (which will be determined by the Board of Officers), the duties usually appertaining to that office shall be performed by the Vice President. He shall serve as Chairman of any Board of Officers meeting. He shall serve as Director of social and noncompetitive activities. He shall also actively promote the name of N.R.L. in the community. (amended 7/11/2023)

Section 4. Duties of the Secretary

The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and officers and shall record all minutes and the outcome of all votes. He shall submit for publishing in the newsletter or by email to all members who have provided an email address. He shall give all notices of meetings to the members required by law or these bylaws and shall perform all duties incidental to this office required by law or the majority vote of the officers. He shall have custody of the Club's records and keep all Club correspondence. He shall be responsible for absentee voting as detailed in Article IV, Section 2 and Article IX. In the absence of the Secretary from any meeting, a Secretary pro tempore shall be chosen by the presiding Officer. The Secretary shall also act as Club Historian if one is not appointed by the President. (amended 7/11/2023 and 12/12/2023)

Section 5. <u>Duties of the Treasurer</u>

The Treasurer shall, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be made by the officers, have custody of all monies, debts, and obligations belonging to the Club. He shall receive monies for the Club and deposit it in the Club account. All CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DRAFTS, NOTES OR OTHER ORDERS FOR PAYMENT OF MONEY SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE TREASURER AND PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT. If these three positions are held by the same member, another co-signer will be selected by the Board of Officers. Also, a co-signer

may not be of the same household or related by blood or marriage to the Treasurer. If this should occur, another co-signer will be selected by the Board of Officers. (amended July 2006 and 7/11/2023)

The Treasurer shall prepare a budget for approval by the Board of Officers. Any payments within 10% of the budgeted amount or not exceeding \$25 of the budgeted amount may be paid by the Treasurer. If an obligation does not meet these criteria, the payment must be approved by the Board of Officers. The Treasurer shall give a report on the financial status of the Club at the monthly meeting, and, if so requested, at any other meeting of the Officers. (amended 7/11/2023)

The Treasurer shall also be responsible for maintaining the Corporate and Not-For-Profit status of the Club.

Section 6. <u>Duties of the N.C.C.C. Governor</u>

The Governor shall attend the N.C.C.C. meeting(s) in accordance with N.C.C.C. rules, and shall be reimbursed by the Club for such expenses as approved by the Board of Officers. His duty shall be in compliance with the duties outlined in the N.C.C.C. Rule Book.

Section 7. Duties of the Director of Competition

The Director of Competition shall be responsible for the administration of all Club sanctioned and Competition events. He shall be the resident authority for any conversation relative to competition. He shall also be in charge of award acquisition for any Club oriented events.

Section 8. <u>Duties of the Membership Director</u>

The Membership Director shall be charged with the responsibility for keeping up-to-date records of all members. He shall be in charge of collecting monies due for membership, both initial and renewal. He shall be in charge of selling club property at the Club function. He shall be responsible for contacting all prospective members who have expressed an interest in Club membership. (amended 7/11/2023)

Section 9. Duties of the Publication Director

The Publication Director shall be in charge of Club newsletter. He shall be the Editor, Writer, Publisher and distributor of this publication. At his discretion he may designate any or all of these functions to volunteers. If done so, he shall be final authority and hold full responsibility for this publication, within reason. (amended 7/11/2023)

Section 10. Duties of the Director of Public Relations

The Director of Public Relations shall be responsible for the advertising of upcoming Club events, and also for any post event articles. He shall also be responsible for promoting the name of the Club in the community.

Section 11. Duties of the Sergeant-At-Arms

The Sergeant-At-Arms will be the policing body at any Club function, or gathering of Club members. He shall keep order at the meetings and use whatever methods are necessary to do so, including physical expulsion. He shall do his best to protect any Club property as well as the personal property of any member and guests. He shall also be charged with the responsibility of assisting the Membership director in making any guests feel welcome. (amended July 2006)

General Regulations

- Saturday and Sunday are both 7 Event Days.
- Times will be posted, but participants are encouraged to view them via their smartphones.
- Social distancing is suggested in all situations.
- o There is absolutely NO SMOKING OR VAPING ON MCC property.
- o No alcohol or mood modifiers are allowed before, during, or after the event.
- o Racers may be asked to work in order to minimize the number of participants.
- o In case of emergency Dial 911. Your location is 8900- US 14, Crystal Lake.
- o Please put all waste in the trash container and police your area before leaving.
- Knocked down cones are 2 seconds. Cones must be knocked over or completely moved out of the chalked box to earn that 2 second penalty. Lay down cones count. Hitting the cones at the finish line is a DNF. 2 tires on the grass will constitute a DNF.
- Down Cone Policy:
 - If you encounter a down cone on the course STOP, HONK YOUR HORN and get the attention of a corner worker. Proceed to the finish line. You will get a re-run.
 - If you ignore the cone, you may be charged a 2 second penalty for a down cone.
- Red Flag Stop immediately and wait for directions from a corner worker.
- o All pets must be kept on a leash and please clean up after them.
- Northern Illinois Corvette Club owns and operates the timing equipment. Drivers are responsible for damage to the equipment. Hit and you own it. Special thanks to Dale and Carolyn Samuelson.
- Timing and equipment trailers are off limits. Event issues will be handled by Dale Samuelson, Dan Wagner, and Mike Stevens.
- Staging Please be ready when your run group is called. Make sure to return to your same lane for the second run in each event.
- o Run Order- To be described at the Driver's Meeting.
- o There may be a lunch break to be announced at the drivers meeting.
- o In lieu of trophies, a voucher for food the food vendor will be provided for each day of racing.
- Numbers will be assigned by Registration per assigned number list and available numbers.
