COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 80-hour course is designed to prepare an instructor student to obtain the FDLE Commission certification as a Canine Team Training Instructor and instruct the FDLE 1198 480-hour course curriculum. Officers attending will focus on the role of the canine team instructor and the liability of K-9 training involved. The course will cover all academics portions of the curriculum as well as conduct hands on practical instruction, lectures and canine demonstrations. All students must pass a written exam with a minimum 85% and demonstrate 100% knowledge of practical proficiency. Those who attend should be prepared to participate in physical activity and demonstrate proper instruction of a canine topic. Topics include: Obedience, Aggression, Apprehension, Building Search, Area Search, Report Writing, Records Keeping and Canine Course Development. This course fulfills one of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's mandatory requirements to become a Certified K-9 Team Instructor. Handlers should attend with their canines.

INSTRUCTOR:

Scott Clark, Owner and Head Trainer of High Drive K-9, has been a Police Officer for the City of Coral Springs Police Department (FL) since January 1999 and a current K-9 Handler with them since 2001. He has been working and training patrol and detection dogs since 2002. He is a current certified State of Florida FDLE K-9 Team Instructor and FDLE K-9 Team Evaluator. In addition, Scott is the K-9 Unit Head Trainer, Multi-Jurisdictional K-9 Head Trainer, SWAT K-9 Instructor, Team Leader and SWAT Handler, Firearms Instructor, MP5/MP7Instructor, Sig Rifle Instructor and has trained numerous K-9 Teams across the Country. He is a National Instructor for Law Dog, Police K-9 Magazine & K-9 Cop Magazine; as well as, an active writer for Police K-9 Magazine and K-9 Cop Magazine, where several of his articles have been published. He is currently working his second dual-purpose patrol/narcotics dog.

- 4) Be sure to Apply for instructor certification within 4 years of completing the Canine Team Training Instructor Course
