E-Collar course is designed to prepare each K-9 Team with the proper education, introduction, while providing an advanced hand on approach to the E-Collar system. The K-9 Teams will be thoroughly instructed and guided on the utilization of the E-Collar during both training and real-life deployments. Proper use of the E-Collar as a behavior shaping device, a communication tool, and as a corrective measure will be vastly covered. By the end of the course, each K-9 Team will be evaluated to ensure that the handler can correctly read his dog and manipulate the E-Collar correctly.

In addition, the K-9 Bite Building course offers an explosive, disciplined training approach dealing solely with Canine Aggression, Behavior Modification, Controlled Bite work, Civil Engagements, Hidden Sleeves, Muzzles and much more. The results of this combination of courses will directly build, strengthen, and prepare K-9 Teams for Real Life. **40 Hour Certificate Awarded**
