LE-Carnival Night

#### **NOVEMBER 4, 2024**

The next type in the series on learning foliage types is spooned or cupped. According to the AVSA Handbook, "Spooned or Cupped: [Leaves are] concave with high edges like a spoon."

"LE-Carnival Night" (Hybridized by E. Lebetskaia, 2019) is a gorgeous example of medium green spooned foliage. It has beautiful single-semidouble purple large wavy star/white eye, pink and coral puff fantasy blooms.

There are relatively few named cultivars with spooned foliage similar to LE-Carnival Night (LE-Karnaval' naia Noch) pictured above (photo credit: Vladimir Kalgin / AVSA). You can look up other varieties on the AVSA website and using the First Class African violet computer program.

Keep an eye out for a variety with spooned foliage to add to your collection the next time you are looking for a new addition.

## Recipe Box



## SKILLET MACARONI & CHEESE COOK'S ILLUSTRATED "THE BEST SKILLET RECIPES"

- 3 1/2 Cups Water, plus extra as needed
- 1 (12-oz) can evaporated milk
- ounces (about 3 cups) elbow macaroni
- 1 teaspoon cornstarch
- 1/2 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon hot sauce (adjust to taste)
- 6 ounces Monterey Jack cheese, shredded
- 6 ounces cheddar cheese, shredded
- 3 tablespoons unsalted butter Salt and ground black pepper

Bring 3 1/2 cups water, 1 cup of the evaporated milk, the macaroni, and 1/2 teaspoon salt to a simmer in a 12-inch nonstick skillet over high heat. Cook at a vigorous simmer, stirring often, until the macaroni is tender and the liquid has thickened, 9 to 12 minutes. Wisk the remaining 1/2 cup evaporated milk, the cornstarch, mustard, and hot sauce together in a small bowl, then stir into the skillet. Continue to simmer until slightly thickened, about 1 minute. Off the heat, stir in the cheese one handful at a time, adding water as needed to adjust the consistency of the sauce. Stir in the butter, season with salt and pepper to taste.
