This will be a big savings on time and money, but we ask for your patience and help in making it work.

The new entries form allows for pre-entries and should make Sandi Soto's job with entries much easier. She can add your exhibit info into the entries program ahead of time. What if you have some that you are not sure about? Send in all possibilities, it will be easier for her to delete them that day than to add from scratch.

The show menu is a starting place for you to know the basic food that will be offered. Mary Jane took over as Hospitality Chair and has some very healthful offerings for us. PLEASE bring your favorite dishes to share (and the recipes!), especially if you have any dietary restrictions. Also, we wonder how many tables will be required. PLEASE let me know your rough estimates (Show plants AND sale plants).

Do we need to get more tables for all your plants?? Also, be sure to let Mary Lou Harden know if you plan to bring a design or container garden. Affiliate members are those who belong to an affiliate club. They may exhibit and participate in the activities but are NOT allowed to sell in the sales room. Individual members can do it all!

Please look around for appropriate items for the auctions and raffles. We are glad that Carolyn Haug has agreed to be our chairperson. This will be one of the few money makers for AVCF at this event.
