POLICY PRIORITIES

The following are official policies of Tories Australia (TA) as of 18 January 2026, namely that:

National security

- A state of war exists between Australia and Islamic State in The Philippines and Hamas.
 - Any state, person, group, business or charity aiding, promoting or protecting ISIS, Hamas or any other terrorist organisation shall be treated as an enemy of the state and prosecuted according to law.
 - Australian citizens who engage in such conduct will be charged with treason.
- Australia shall formally annul its recognition of the State of Palestine.
- Australia shall permanently relocate its embassy in Israel to Jerusalem, the capital.
- The *Criminal Code Act 1995* (Cth) shall be amended to introduce the Crime of Anti-Semitism, punishable by up to 25 years in jail.
 - 'Anti-Semitism' will not be defined in any legislation as it is incapable of being reduced to words. It will be for the Judicature to decide what is and what isn't Anti-Semitism. However, it will be the defendant's burden to displace the mischief of any statement or thing done that on its face is Anti-Semitic. Private communications in the form of jokes between friends who are Jewish, for example, will be protected.
 - Nothing in the legislation will prevent a Jewish person being charged with the Crime of Anti-Semitism.
- It is the express desire of TA that the Commonwealth urgently pursues international security pacts and mutual defence treaties in respect of the aforementioned terrorist groups with our allies in:
 - The United States of America;
 - The United Kingdom;
 - France;
 - Israel;
 - Canada;
 - South Africa; and
 - Russia and Ukraine.

- The Ode of Remembrance and the Last Post shall be recited and played at all licenced venues in Australia twice daily at 9.59am and 5.59pm local time.
 - Patrons who do not stand, and are able to, or who interrupt and/or pay any disrespect to the Ode shall be liable for criminal prosecution and immediate removal from the venue.
 - Any venue which does not comply with the provisions shall be liable for fines of \$50,000 per instance, payable to the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Child rights and protection

- Any parent, guardian or medical professional who aids or abets a child in procuring gender altering medication; or assists, encourages, arranges, induces or performs any medical procedure with the intent of altering a child's gender shall be liable to be prosecuted for child abuse and dealt with by the criminal justice system.
 - The relevant child's consent, desire, approval or intent shall be irrelevant to establishing guilt.
 - Evidence of the relevant child's consent, desire, approval or intent shall be inadmissible in any civil or criminal proceedings.
- No public servant or government employee, contractor or volunteer shall be permitted to include "pro-nouns" in their email signatures, or any other official communications paid for by the public.
- No child who has undergone, or is undergoing, gender reassignment procedures shall be eligible for selection in any competitive sporting team of a sex other than their sex at birth.

Age and maturity

- Any laws that curtail any person's access to social media by reason of their age shall be repealed. For the avoidance of doubt, it will be illegal to deny a child under the age of 16 access to social media because of their age.
- Social media and artificial/synthetic intelligence studies will be compulsory throughout all Australian primary schools. This will include compulsory tuition in cyber-safety and cryptocurrency and teachers will be encouraged to incorporate social media and AI into lessons.
- There shall be universal suffrage for all Australian citizens aged 21-years-old and above.
- The legal drinking age shall remain at 18, however alcohol may only be purchased by, or sold to, people aged 21-years-old and above.

Fixed terms and midterms

- The House of Representatives shall be dissolved every four years and an election held for all lower house seats on the first Saturday of the relevant financial year.
- Senators shall serve terms of six years, with at least one-third of the Senate to be elected on the first Saturday of every second financial year. The Australian Capital Territory and the

Northern Territory shall not elect Senators at the same election; except in the case of a Double Dissolution.

- Each state shall elect the same number of Senators at each election.

Carbon Refund Scheme

- All individuals, small businesses and companies who at any point in the past 20 years have paid any tax, tariff, levy or fine to any state or federal government in respect of their own carbon emissions shall be refunded in the form of tax deductions that may be rolled over year-to-year until they are fully recompensated.
- In cases where the taxpayer is deceased, their estate and heirs may sue the Commonwealth for refunds of equal value to that which they would have been entitled.
- Any law currently in force designed to limit the emission of carbon for environmental purposes shall be repealed.

Women's Rights

- The burqa, or any other attire whether religious or not, shall not be permitted to be worn in public if it has the effect of concealing the identity and/or diminishing the agency of the wearer.
- A national anonymous hotline and web service will be established for any man or woman in a domestic relationship whose rights and freedoms have been suppressed by the religion or culture of their spouse, their family or their spouse's family.
- A report to the hotline shall if necessary be referred to state police.

Education

- Every student shall study the Holocaust in Years 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 and will be centrally examined on what they have learned by the Federal Government. No student will be issued a leaving certificate without passing the test, which shall be marked blindly.
- If a student fails the test, they must resit a new test or remain at school and continue studies of the Holocaust until they pass.
- Schools must not exhibit or display any form of political advertising on their premises, websites or social media channels including, but not limited to:
 - material that encourages children to pursue or engage in gender reassignment;
 - rainbow flags or 'LGBTQI+' materials;
 - material that encourages children to limit carbon emissions for environmental purposes; and
 - keffiyehs, or any other ethnoreligious attire worn for political purposes.
- Any university student who is unable to attend class due to their lecturer or tutor being on strike for the purposes of attending a political demonstration will have their entire semester refunded in full, at the expense of the university.
- No student may be charged any money or incur any debt for attending any lesson that begins with a Welcome to Country, or any other form of political, religious or non-educational statement and may apply to unenroll or change class at any time without penalty to avoid such displays.



Welfare and economy

- Any person with at least \$10,000 in superannuation savings shall be permitted to withdraw:
 - five per cent of their balance each financial year if employed; or
 - if registered with unemployment services, 15 per cent.
 - Any person may access the entirety of their superannuation without restriction at the age of 50.
- All public funds saved by operation of the above policies shall be redirected to increasing the aged pension.
- Australia Post shall operate 24 hours per day, 7 days per week and on all public holidays.
- Traditional fuel in the form of petroleum will not be taxed or levied with the intent of curbing its use for environmental purposes. Abundance of cheaper oil will be paramount.

Energy

- All subsidies for energy production that is less efficient than the most efficient, shall cease immediately.
- Any company wishing to invest in nuclear energy must be Australian-owned and will be matched dollar-for-dollar by the Federal Government following confirmation of viability so that ownership of nuclear power generation will initially be split between the public and private sectors.

Immigration

- Permanent resident visas; or other visas with more than three months' validity shall be available for a fee of \$25,000.
- In rare and extraordinary circumstances (for example, a recognised team of touring professional cricketers), the fee may be waived by the Minister for Immigration following recommendation by department officials.
- Study visas for students of sporting or academic excellence will be free to those who submit to thorough vetting procedures by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

Indigenous rights and protection against racism

- Indigenous Australians shall in all respects be treated as proud and equal citizens and no law shall be passed by any government, whether state or federal, that has the effect of defining indigenous Australians whether by legislation or amendments to the Constitution.
- No group, whether defined by ethnicity, religion or race, shall be permitted any "voice" to parliament other than that which is (or is not) conveyed by the force of its collective vote at regular elections.
