I was looking for a way to fit this place into my trip schedule, and was thinking 2026, but Allways informed me that they were filling up quickly with bookings, so I decided to go to 2027 whilst we had the opportunity to do so. In doing this, Beqa Lagoon Resort agreed to let us come for '24 prices! By the time you see this, the prices will already have gone up!

At 9.10am on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July we leave Melbourne for Fiji, arriving at 4pm. No overnight flights on this trip!! Bonus!!!


We stay the first night at the Fiji Gateway Hotel, which is very close to the airport in Nadi.

The Saturday morning we will drive to Pacific Harbour on the southern coast of Viti Levu, which is a two to three hour trip depending on the traffic. From there we will get on a boat and travel a half hour or so out to Beqa Island and our resort for the next week.

Our resort is the best one I have stayed at in Fiji. It is beautifully set out, the rooms are great, and there is a lot to do on the island.




It is the diving we are here for though.



Beqa Lagoon is seriously underrated. The coral here is prolific and colourful, and the fish life terrific. Golden Arches is a dive site that stands out in my memory, as it has a large arch covered in yellow soft corals. There are fishing boat wrecks, shallow reef dives and walls. There's a couple of dozen dive sites to choose from.

However, it is the Cathedral Dive site that we are here for. This dive is a shark feeding dive that concentrates on Tiger Sharks. The first dive here will see us descend to around 30m where we will see tiger sharks, bull sharks, lemon sharks, tawny nurse sharks and possibly silvertip sharks. Blacktip reef sharks, grey reef sharks and whitetip reef sharks can also be seen here. A second dive will go down to about the 15m mark when we do it all again. This is one of the most exhilarating dives you will ever do.



These sharks can be very big, but we will nearly have as many guides/shark handlers as divers, so the dive is done very professionally and safely. If you would like to come but not do these shark dives, we can organise that. We have one shark double dive organised in this package. Beqa Lagoon Resort only lets you book one before you get there, but it should be possible for those interested to book onto a second shark day whilst we are there.

For the non-divers there is plenty to do. There are walks to the local villages, another to a peak, snorkelling from the beach (Conny says its good, I haven't seen it.) There is a spa, they do yoga sessions, there is nightly entertainment, and Beqa Island is the home to the firewalkers. They do a firewalking session once a week and it is quite amazing! Its also a brilliant place to just relax by the pool with a book.
