Everett, President; Mark Carmouche, Vice-President; Rob Runyon, Secretary/Treasurer; Members of the Board: Jerry Stratton, Tomkickern Mike Billbe, Jim Tanner and Don Stump along with the current officers. That motion was seconded and upon voice vote the motion was approved.
