Apache Hills Road Association met on Oct 1 at 7:24 P.M. Meeting opened by Roger Everette. Number of lots present, 19, number of proxy's, 9. Total lots, 28.

Minutes read by Margaret Stump, motion to approve made by Betty Tate, seconded by Jerry Stratton. Treasury balance \$8986.59 reported by Rob Runyon. Check charges not investigated as requested last year. Motion to approve treasurer's report made by Roger Everette, seconded by Betty Tate.

No action taken on delinquent accounts.

Roger Everette contacted Easy Ride and Stanley Wallace. Easy Ride gave estimate of \$8000 to do some repairs and seal coat. Midwest paving gave estimate of \$12,000/ Easy Ride and Stanley Wallace were contacted again and asked to reduce the price and work with us. No actual dollar figure given to job.

Curt Fanning said Jerco Enterprise advised that after 2 oil and chip jobs roads will still be cracked if done again. It needs road base replaced to hold up. He stated that approximately \$19,000 has been spent so far and the money would be better spent to fix the base. Estimated cost of removing asphalt and repacking base and replacing with gravel \$15,000. Bob Fontenot stated the purpose of the road association is to maintain to the best of our ability with the money available. The money spent so far has been only to maintain.

The Road Maintaince agreement was explained to those in attendance. Jerry Stratton suggests to chip and seal road again since cracks and holes are getting severe.

Roger Everette has been unable to get with Stanley Wallace the Cty Commissioner, so no answer on taking over Apache Hills road as well as Richland's roads.

Motion made to authorize the use of best judgment on resurfacing road up to \$8000 by Jerry Stratton and seconded by Bob Fontenot. If estimate exceeds amount the board will wait until next year.

Motion made by Elbert Flickner to keep the dues at \$75 per lot, seconded by Bob Fontenot., motion carried.

Motion to retain present officers made by Bob Fontenot seconded by Elbert Flickner, motion carried.
