

What does the Solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrate?

Also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, this feast honors Jesus Christ, Really, Truly, and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance") when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in remembrance of Me."

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi

(Lect 169-Year C)

The disciples realize they have a problem. They have but five loaves and two fish, and thousands of mouths to feed. No known math could solve this problem. But Jesus' math is different. He who one day would transform a loaf of bread and a cup of wine into his own Body and Blood sacrificed for all of humanity, recognizes that the food he can provide will satisfy thousands of hungry people with more left over than they begin with. Today, millions of people go hungry and countless others need some other important resource, from housing to health care. We may feel as helpless as the disciples did in that deserted place, unable to provide anywhere near enough. But we cannot forget that we are truly the body of Christ. As the body of Christ, we can offer ourselves up to those in need. When we do so, we can provide food for the hungry, shelter for the homeless, hospitality for the alien, comfort for the grieving, justice for the oppressed, forgiveness for the sinner, hope for the despairing, mercy for the lost and forsaken. This, too, we can do in remembrance of him.
