



CI-128, a dangerous abortion initiative, is being falsely promoted as a citizen-led effort to “keep the government out of our personal lives” and protect “women’s healthcare decisions.” However, beneath these slogans lies a troubling reality—CI-128 is designed to dismantle pro-life efforts in Montana by rendering abortion regulations—past, present, and future—unconstitutional.
