Solemnity of Pentecost Sunday
(Lect 63—Year C)

The Holy Spirit has the power to transform us. The first disciples can attest to that. When the Holy Spirit descends upon them, they are able to speak in different tongues, allowing everyone in the crowd to understand them in his or her own language. Jesus tells the disciples that receiving the Holy Spirit enables them to forgive sins. At the Last Supper, he tells them that the Holy Spirit will teach them and guide them. Saint Paul preaches that the Holy Spirit makes us one, unifying us as one body of Christ, which enables us to recognize that we are all children of God. We are those disciples now, having received the Holy Spirit in baptism and confirmation. The power to be transformed is within us now. Today’s Gospel acclamation calls for that transformation: “Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.” We may not see literal tongues of fire descending upon us, but the Holy Spirit has the power to fire up our hearts with the love that is Jesus’ command, to be offered to God and to our neighbor. For it is that kind of love—the selfless, sacrificial love that Jesus modeled—that can transform us into the kind of person of whom others will say, “the Spirit of God dwells in you” (Romans 8:9).

How will you show the fire of God’s love to others this week?
