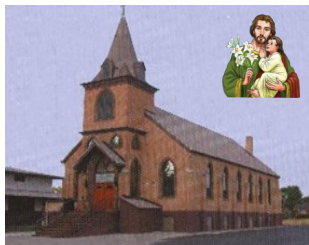

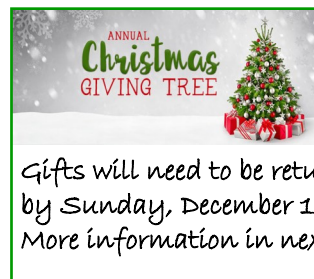

Monday, December 16: Misa de Gallo, for the Filipino community. Mass at 5:30 p.m.

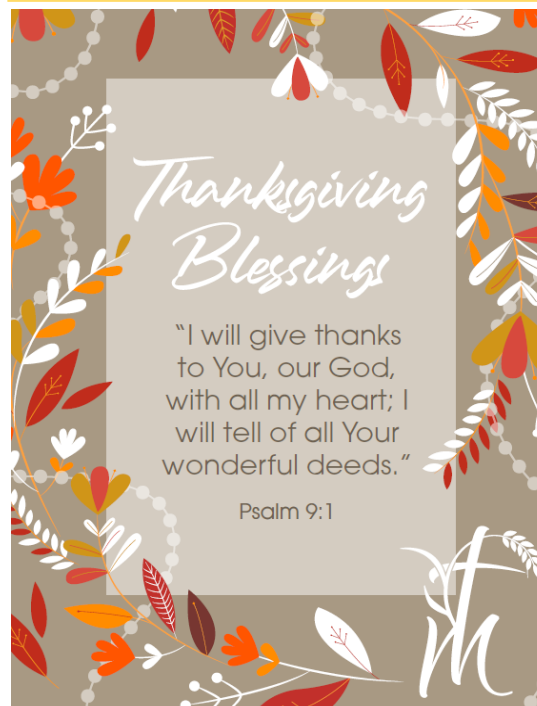
