#### SPECIAL INVITATION CARDS FROM JESUS

Jesus in today's gospel (Matthew 11:25-30) gives out invitation cards to each one of us. The invitation reads: "Come to me all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my voke upon you and learn from me for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves...."

Jesus knew what it means to pass through difficulties. He understands our struggles. And He is full of love and compassion. Imagine how Jesus wept at the death of Lazarus in John 11:35 seeing the grief and sorrow of Mary and Martha. In Luke 7:11-35 Jesus consoled the widow of Nain who lost her only son and raised him up for her. He is concerned about our problems. He has a human heart filled with divine love. That was why he asked us to come to him and have rest.

Sometimes we don't have the peace of mind we deserve, the joy and happiness we deserve because of so many worries. Now Jesus tells us to come to him and have rest. Let us honor this invitation today for our own good. Let's go to him! (Hymn: Come to Jesus just now).

When he said 'take my yoke upon you.... ' He is asking you to submit yourself to him, surrender and trust in him that he is with you in your life challenges. John 16:33 "In the world you will have troubles but take heart, I have overcome the world." John 14:1 "Let not your hearts be troubled, trust in God, trust also in me...." We must always know that Jesus is with us, and he is able to take care of our concerns. Let us trust in him. Worries, anxieties, fears cannot solve any problems.

There was a pope, so many years ago. This pope was so much anxious and bothered about the problems facing the church then to the extent that he couldn't sleep at night as he was busy thinking about these problems. At a point he

learned how to surrender these problems to Jesus. Whenever it was time for bed, he would tell Jesus, "Sir I am going to bed take care of your church." And he would sleep soundly. Imitate this pope and allow Jesus to take care of your worries.

Isaiah 43 and Psalm 23 assure us that God is with us during our problems and that we should trust in him always.
