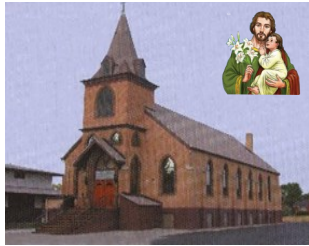

THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER

Today's gospel (Matt 13:1-23) is about the parable of the Sower told by Jesus. The seed sown is the love of God planted in every human heart. God is so generous with his love that like the rain which he sends to both for the good and the bad (Matt. 5:45) his love is shown both to the good and the bad people on earth. This is what is represented by the seeds being scattered all over by the Sower, on the rocky ground, on the walking path, on the thorns and on the good rich soil.

The good people are the rich soil on which the seed fell. Faith in them is the ground which receives the seed and makes it grow. They are the people who appreciate God's love and reciprocate it by loving God back and bearing good fruits. The bad people in their evil inclination rejected God's love and bears no good fruits.

We are that good rich soil. The faith in us receives the word of God which makes us to come here every weekend to worship God. The faith in us expresses itself in the love we show daily to God and to fellow human beings, in the charity work we do, in the sacrifices we make for the sake of the gospel and salvation of souls. We face challenges in life, yet we keep our faith and still serve God. The good lives we live are the good fruits we produce.

This faith we have in God must grow daily. The love of God in us must grow daily. But remember that if a farmer does not attend to his growing seeds and takes off the weeds growing around them, the weeds can grow and choke or suffocate the good seed and the seed may die. In the same way there are weeds that may grow and suffocate the love of God in us. Such weeds include constant worries, negative thoughts, sadness of heart, feelings of guilt, lack of trust in God. We must not allow these weeds to grow and kill the love of God in us.

These bad feelings must always come but we

should not allow them to develop in our lives. Like the farmer that fights the weeds in his farm, fight these bad feelings and allow God's love in you to stand high and control your life. The love of God must be a dominating force and feelings in us (2 Cor 5:14). God can never stop loving us. His steadfast love never ceases (Lamentation 3:22-23).
