Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles
(Lect. 591)

It is hard to imagine how the Christian faith would have grown to become what it is today without the firm foundation and extensive expansion that Saints Peter and Paul provided. But it is even harder to imagine any two people who appeared less likely to fulfill such roles! When Jesus was arrested, Simon Peter denied him three times and fled. But after he rose, Jesus took Simon aside and asked him three times if he loved him, telling him to tend his flock. Simon likely recalled when Jesus had given him the name Peter, calling him the rock upon which he would build his church. Saul, later, tried to destroy that church, imprisoning and executing scores of Christians. But the risen Lord confronted Saul on the road to Damascus, transforming his zeal for traveling all over the provinces persecuting Christians to traveling all over the known world baptizing Gentiles. Jesus saw something in each one and chose them to lead and expand the church. They provide a lesson for all of us that with the grace of God, our pasts do not determine our futures.
