Season of Lent 2025

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th and ends before the celebration of Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday, April 17th.



Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Lect. 84-Year C)

Few of us have perfect uncorrected 20/20 vision in each eye. So why do we assume that we have perfect uncorrected “vision” of good and bad, of who’s at fault or who’s to blame? Today, Jesus presents a dramatic example of someone who is more concerned about a small splinter affecting someone else’s vision rather than a huge beam that’s blocking their own. Finding fault with others while ignoring our own sins is very human. But Jesus calls us to a new way of seeing. Last week he told us, “Stop judging and you will not be judged” (Luke 6:37). And two weeks ago: “Blessed are you when people... insult ... and de-nounce [you]” (Luke 6:22). We shouldn’t judge others and we are blessed when others judge us unfairly. Let this be a timely lesson as we look toward Lent. It is far more important to overcome our own imperfections than to waste time judging or denouncing others. Like the Corinthians, we can then devote ourselves to the work of the Lord, bearing good fruit out of the goodness that God nurtures in our hearts.

What will you do during Lent to stop focusing on what’s wrong in the world or in others and devote yourself to doing something fruitful instead?
