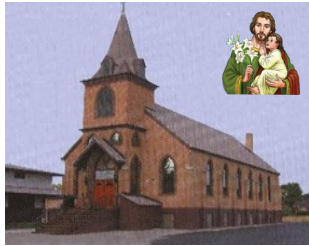

#### Catholic Social Services of Montana donates \$4,125.87 to St. Joseph's

As a part of its Disaster Relief Program, Catholic Social Services of Montana (CSSM) has donated \$4,125.87 to St. Joseph's for the purpose of repairing damages caused by the flooding in 2023. Additionally, CSSM used nearly \$5,700 to help numerous families in Hardin with similar needs.

CSSM is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that has serves the Dioceses of Great Falls-Billings and Helena with their—

- Adoption Services. They have built thousands of Montana families since 1953.
- Baby Boutiques. Locations in Billings and Helena distribute diapers, wipes, and other essentials free-of-charge to families in need. They are on pace to distribute nearly 50,000 diapers this year.
- Disaster Relief Program. They have received \$70,000 in grant dollars the last two years to aid victims of natural disasters as they look to regain normalcy in their lives.
- Mental Health Counseling. They actively accept and provide counseling for clients in-person (Helena) or through telehealth anywhere in Montana. They provide these services for anyone, observe all Catholic teachings in their therapy, offer 1 session free, and accept insurance, Medicaid, and private pay on a sliding fee scale. Their counselor is a practicing Catholic and has experience with clients from all backgrounds, cultures, and age groups in Montana.
