"He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire," John told his followers, describing the baptism Jesus would offer (Luke 3:16). The Holy Spirit brings God's presence into us, guides us in the Lord's way, and remains with us forever. Fire can be used to refine or purify, as when it's used to burn the chaff that's been separated from the wheat or to burn away impurities in gold. But fire can also refer to the intense passion that's kindled deep inside us when we are profoundly moved by someone or something. Remember the disciples on the way to Emmaus who encountered the risen Jesus and asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" (Luke 24:32). We are those disciples now. Baptized with the Holy Spirt and fire, we gather together in the risen Lords presence and listen to the scriptures. We have had that fire within us since our baptism, ever ready to be kindled our hearts. Like those disciples of Emmaus, who immediately went out to relate their encounter with Christ, may we be driven to relate in word and deed the presence of the Holy Spirit within us.

When have you felt afire in the spirit, eager to act in the Lord's name?
