## Fourth Sunday of Lent (Lect. 33 - Year C)

"Your brother was dead and has come to life again" (Luke 15:32). Approaching Easter, the readings we hear testify that with God, the dead can be restored to life. The Chosen People, rescued from slavery, celebrate their new life in the promised land. Saint Paul tells the Corinthians that our old selves have passed away, for we have become a new creation in Christ. Finally, we hear the well-known parable of the prodigal son, which concludes with the line above. When the younger son, inheritance squandered and dving of hunger, returns to his father, his father cannot contain his joy, reconciling with him at once. In a way, another person has been brought back to life in this parable, for by demanding his inheritance, the younger son was acting as if his father was already dead. Even when he came to his senses, he presumed he'd treat his father strictly as an employer, not as his father. But with God, reconciliation can transform us, reuniting the estranged, rescuing the lost, restoring the dead to life. On this Laetare Sunday, let us rejoice in God's' power even over death.

With whom can you reconcile, restoring life to a difficult relationship?

# THE CHRISM MASS



he bishop celebrates the Chrism Mass with the priests of the diocese. It is a manifestation of the priests' communion with their bishop. At this Mass, the Bishop blesses the holy oils that will be used for the celebrations of the Sacraments throughout the year. This is a celebration of the MINISTRY of all in the Diocese. While our diocese is made up of many different parishes and unique gifts and needs, we are in communion with one another: We are ONE church; TOGETHER we are the ONE BODY OF CHRIST.

he Chrism Mass reminds us that when the Church anoints the Sick for healing, it is Christ who heals. When the Church anoints catechumens for strength in their conversion, it is Christ who gives them strength. When the Church anoints the newly baptized with the Sacred CHRISM; confirms the baptism of men and women in confirmation with the CHRISM: anoints the hands of the priest or the head, of the bishop in holy orders with CHRISM; anoints a new altar, the Table of the Lord, and the walls of a new church with CHRISM: IT IS THE GRACE OF CHRIST, THE HOLY SPIRIT, that permeates and becomes one with the baptized, the confirmed, the ordained, the altar, the house for the church

We should be at the Chrism Mass because the life of Christ dwells within us, because we have been anointed and we have been sent to Go Make
