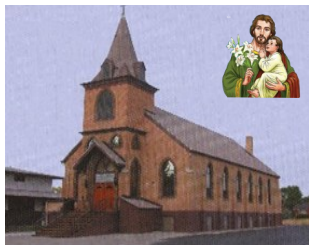

A letter from Bishop Jeffrey M Fleming to all the faithful of the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings has been placed on the table at the entrance of the church. This letter announces a Plenary Jubilee Year 2025 granted by the Holy Father, Pope Francis. The Holy Father desires that the theme of the Holy Year be the witness of the Church as "Pilgrims of Hope". The letter includes where to gain the Jubilee Indulgence and what the conditions are for Gaining the Plenary Indulgence along with additional provisions.

The six churches where the Jubilee Indulgence may be gained are:

1. St. Ann Cathedral, Great Falls
2. St. Patrick Co-Cathedral, Billings
3. St. Xavier, St. Xavier
4. Immaculate Conception, Wolf Point
5. St. Mary, Rocky Boy
6. Sacred Heart, Miles City



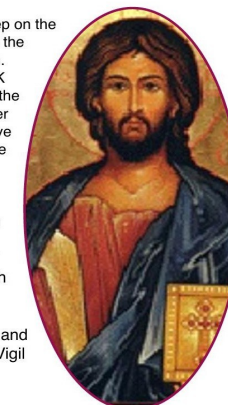
Catholic Daughters of the Americas

Father Leonard Bachmann Graduate Scholarships will be awarded to three persons who have completed Undergraduate studies and who desire assistance for tuition in order to continue studies on the graduate level. Applications are on the table at the entrance of the church in the gray folder.

Also, two National Scholarships will be awarded to 8th grade students entering the 9th grade in the Fall of 2025 to a Catholic High School. Application forms are on the table in the navy folder.

What is the RITE OF ELECTION and the CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION?

THE RITE OF ELECTION is the second step on the catechumens journey and leads them into the more intense period of Lenten preparation. Those chosen inscribe their names in the BOOK OF THE ELECT as a promise of faithfulness to the call they have received from Christ. At the Easter Vigil, they will be baptized, confirmed and receive Eucharist. Thus they will be fully initiated into the Body of Christ.



THE CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION is the final preparation for those who, already baptized in another Christian faith, wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist. The Church invites them to hear anew the Lord's call to continual conversion and to be faithful to their Baptism. At the Easter Vigil these candidates will share fully in the Sacramental life of the Catholic Church.

As they seek to become one with us, it is only fitting that we should be present to welcome and support them.

These celebrations occur every year in our Diocese at the beginning of Lent. This year they will be celebrated in 3 locations, to allow as many people as possible to attend this celebration.
