SOLEMNITY OF MARY MOTHER OF GOD

Today is the first day of the year 2023. It's a day of gratitude to God for allowing us to see another year. To him be all the glory and honour for ever and ever. Amen.

Today the church celebrates the solemnity of Mary, the mother of God. This feast is placed on this first day of the year because Blessed Virgin Mary played a very important role in the salvation of mankind. She is the door through which God the son, the light of the world entered the human world. St. Paul mentioned that in the second reading (Gal 4:4-7) when he said that God the Father sent his son born of a woman so that we might receive adoptions as God's children. God the son took flesh in the womb of Blessed Virgin Mary. She gave birth to him on December 25th. That was the feast we celebrated 7 days ago.

As the mother of Jesus, Mary is also our mother since we are adopted children of God. We are brothers and sister of Jesus Christ. She is a loving and a caring mother. She is a great intercessor. These blessings are contained in the first reading (Num. 6: 22-27) of today. And I declare these blessings to you at this Mass: May the Lord bless you and keep you; May the Lord let his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; May the Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace; May God bless you in his mercy. Amen. It's my prayers that this year will be a year of divine visitation to each of us; a year of uncommon favours from the Lord; a year of breakthrough. When God gave Sarah the wife of Abraham a child in her old

age, Sarah exclaimed 'God has given me a cause to laugh and all who hear this good news will laugh with me'(Gen.21:6). This year God will give you a cause to laugh and to be abundantly happy. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, the mother of God and our mother continues to intercede for us.

On a day like this we are reminded of the need to make New Year resolutions. It is a renewed commitment to serve God better in the New Year. May God help us in our resolves.
