### DO NOT BE AFRAID FOR GOD IS STRONGER THAN YOUR SOURCE OF FEAR

In the first reading of today (1 Kings 19:9-13) prophet Elijah was faced with a threat to his life from the wicked gueen Jezebel and her husband Ahab. He ran for his life and sought the help of God. God answered him. He encountered God in a gentle breeze. Elijah found consolation, comfort, peace, and protection from God.

The Apostles in today's gospel (Matt. 14:22-33) had their boat tossed about by the waves of the sea and by heavy storms. They were in great danger. Looking up they saw someone walking on the water towards them. Thinking it was a ghost, they were highly terrified. But Jesus spoke to them "take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Jesus entered the boat, calmed down the storm.

We are daily being tormented by storms of life, problems of various kinds. Jesus assure us of his presence during our turbulent times. He tells us not to be afraid that he is with us to support us and to lift us up even when we are sinking in the sea of life. John 16:33 he said "In the world you will have hardships but be courageous, I've conquered the world."

When Jesus tells us "Do not be afraid," he is not inviting us to deny our source of fear but rather to take off our attention on our source of fear, and to focus on him for he is stronger than our source of fear. The problem we have is that most often we focus our attention on our source of fear instead of focusing on God. Psychologically, what you pay attention to, what you concentrate on influences your life. If you focus on your challenges and problems, they will weigh you down. But if you focus on God who is more powerful than those problems you will receive the needed help.

This was the case with Peter. When he requested Jesus to allow him to walk on the water Jesus asked him to come on. He started walking on the water because he was focusing on Jesus his God. But when he began to focus on the storms and how strong the wind was, he began to sink. But Peter was smart enough to call upon Jesus for help. He shouted, "Lord save me." Jesus stretched out his hand and saved him. Hebrews 12:2 said 'Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus...' Let us place our faith strongly in Jesus and call upon him in prayer always. Like Elija and Peter, we shall find help and peace from God.
