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The Market Is Starting To SLOW!

If you've been watching the news lately, you've likely seen that the real estate market is starting to slow. More accurately, I'd call it "normalized", as we're just starting to cool off from being red hot for several years.

The truth is that we are just a few months short of having the longest economic recovery in American history. In turn, that means we are overdue for our next change in cycle. In general, real estate goes in 4- to 6-year cycles, although the San Antonio market tends to stay more stable than many markets across the US. We recovered from the Mortgage Meltdown of 2008 in 2013 and have seen an increase in year over year values every year since. The land grab of 2020-2021 did inflate prices significantly, and what we've been seeing with price reductions on listings the past few months is partially a reset from that intensity.

For most homeowners, what looks like falling values is nothing to be nervous about; remember real estate goes in cycles, but values continue to rise over the long term, which reminds us that real estate is a wonderful vehicle for wealth, it just doesn't happen overnight.


If you don't need to move in the next couple of years, you may want to stay put. Having said that, many people who need to sell right now are finding that when their home is priced correctly and marketed properly, they are still getting great results. If you've been waiting to buy, the market is more balanced now, and negotiations can be turned in your favor. It's a good time to consider looking at investment properties.

In our local market, the only people who really may feel a pinch are those who bought in the last couple of years and have to sell soon. And if this is you, in certain situations we're still able to preserve any equity you've gained.

Even though we're in the middle of what may become the longest economic recovery in our country's history, there's a good chance that locally, our 3% year over year appreciation trend may continue. However, the slowing of the real estate market overall means it may continue along a corrective path for a while longer. None of us can truly predict what will happen over the next couple of years, so this discussion is just an example of what MAY happen in the real estate market. While many things can be predictive, they certainly aren't guaranteed.

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NOVEMBER MAINTENANCE

1. Weatherproof the house

Locate and seal cracks and spaces that let heat out and cold air in—along baseboards, wall/ceiling junctures, windows and doors, lighting fixtures, switches, and electrical outlets. Your wallet will thank you, because energy savings from reducing drafts range from 5% to 30% per year, according to the U.S. Department of Energy.

2. Check fire alarms

Dead batteries cause 24% of smoke alarm failures. You should replace batteries or test hard-wired fire alarms twice a year- the time change is a great time.

3. Service the HVAC system

Make sure your heating system is running safely and efficiently so you'll stay toasty during cold weather and save money on energy bills.
