- 3. All vendors must be unloaded and moved and set up NO LATER than 8:30 am. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 4. All vendors booths will be assigned upon receipt of payment and signed application and waiver. Payment or applications will not be accepted the day of the event.
- 5. Vendors will not be able to leave event or take down booth prior to event ending for any reason other than medical issues or you will be banned from event for 1 year.
- 6. **Th.e following will not be sold or displayed during event:** Eggs, live animals, political propaganda or.drug paraphernalia, silly string, canned string, Marshmallow Guns, and canned Farts NO EXCEPTIONS!!

- 7. We will limit the number of direct sales, each company must be approved. We will only allow one representative from each company. The first representative to send in payment with application form will receive the booth space.
- 8. It is important to fill out the description of items being sold on application form; we reserve the right to limit applications based on type of items sold. Available booth space is first c me first serve.
