You are cordially invited to the <u>16th Annual Household Pet Open Cat Show</u> sponsored by the Sheboygan County 4-H Cat Project. This is an open fun show for Household Pet cats and the people who love them. <u>You do not need to be a</u> <u>4-H member to show your cat</u>. This show is for cats and kittens over the age of 4 months. Adults are over 8 months old and must be spayed or neutered to be shown. PREGNANT CATS CANNOT BE SHOWN! Kittens will be judged separately.

The show is on a NEW weekend and at a NEW location!!!

THEME: "Jungle Cats" Use theme for cage decorations & costume class (dress the cat and/or yourself.)

FORMAT: TWO RINGS, TWO JUDGES, each judge doing specialty. 10 Longhair and 20 Shorthair adults will final in each ring. 3 Kittens will final in each ring. Each entry that is judged will receive a Participation Ribbon. Each cat that finals will receive a Rosette. Exceptional Awards will be given at the close of the day.

All cats must have their nails clipped or be declawed and be vaccinated. If your cat does not pass vetting in, we cannot refund your fees. **Bring proof of vaccination.** Your cat should be brought to the show in a carrier or box or on a leash. Cages are available (22x22x22); bring suitable material to cover back, sides and top of cage. If you have a cage you want to bring, please do so. Please be sure your cat is comfortable during the day (bring food, water and a litter box). **NO cats are to be sold at this show.**

Doors open at 7:30 a.m.

Judging begins at 9:00 a.m. SHARP!!!

HELPFUL HINTS: A spay is an altered female cat. A neuter is an altered male cat. Cats are pattern and color classified. This will be verified at check-in, as there are always exceptions.

CAT COLORS: Grey is called BLUE. Orange is called RED. Light Tan is called CREAM. Black is called BLACK. **Cat Patterns**: If your cat is all one color it is a SOLID. Solid cats with white areas (larger than a quarter) are called SOLID & WHITE. If your cat's ears, tail, muzzle and feet are darker than the rest of the body, and the cat has blue eyes, it is a POINTED CAT. If your cat has stripes on its body and an "M" on its forehead, it is a TABBY. If your TABBY cat has a significant amount of white, it is a TABBY & WHITE. If your cat has a mixed coat of red and black (no white), it is a TORTOISESHELL. If your cat has patches of red, black and a distinct area of white, it is a TORTIE & WHITE. If the coloring in your Tortoiseshell is Blue and Cream, it is a DILUTE TORTOISESHELL. If your cat's coat is much lighter underneath, it is a SHADED cat.

If you are unsure of your cat's color or pattern, send a photo with your entry!
