Exhibitors will have until **4:59pm** on **February 15, 2024**, to upload or hand deliver (see red box below) supporting documentation for online entries. Complete entries include online entry plus Exhibitor Signature Form with all signatures, breed, age (Junior, Intermediate or Senior), sex and variety (color), and entry fee. *Incomplete entries will not be accepted. Upload or Hand deliver* (see red box) a copy of your online receipt, exhibitor signature form and supporting documents to the fair office located at:

- 2. Deliver by hand to MCF office, by appointment only.

RABBIT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. **This show is NOT an ARBA Sanctioned Show** ~ *only Maricopa County Residents are eligible to enter.* Rabbits will, however, be judged following the rules and guidelines under ARBA.
- 2. Exhibitor must own and be raising rabbit on or before February 13, 2024. No exceptions.
- 3. Exhibitor must indicate if they wish to sell a qualifying animal at time of entry. Once you have made this declaration, you will not be allowed to change this declaration. If more than 1 are eligible for the sale that were marked "Y", exhibitor MUST complete a Sale Declaration form and turn it into the Coordinator by 7pm, the night of the confirmation/breed show. If no form is received, committee/auction clerk will determine which eligible animal will sell.
- 4. A copy of Pedigree papers must be provided on entry deadline day.
- 5. Entries must have a legible, clearly defined tattoo ~ in the left ear. This must be done prior to receiving day. No tattooing will be done on the fairgrounds.
- 6. Indicate breed and age of rabbit ~ ex: Division = Breed, Class = Color, Subclass = Age/Sex. Sample- Mini Rex, Blue, Senior Buck = Division 3731, Class 163C. Do not use birth date or indicate age by months and years. If you are uncertain about the age of your animal, contact your leader, advisor, or the Department Coordinator.

- 7. Rabbits with evidence of parasites or contagious disease will be disqualified and returned to owner for removal from building or quarantined. Unruly, mean and biting animals will not be accepted.
- 8. Breeding animals at the fairgrounds is prohibited. A doe that has babies at the fair will forfeit wins.
- 9. Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. NO GLASS. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Morning feedings must be done by 10 am and evening feedings must be done by 8:00 pm.
- 10. Maricopa County Fair is not responsible for any loss or damage to animals, equipment, etc. that might occur. Entries are made and accepted on this condition.
- 11. The fair is not responsible for animals left after specified release times.
- 12. Rabbits cannot be removed from cages without permission from the Department Superintendent. Notify Superintendent for showmanship. Double divided cages will be used.
- 13. Exhibitors do not place anything in rabbit cages without permission from the Superintendent. Violation can result in disqualification.
- 14. Do Not attach "for sale" cards to cages. If you are found to be attempting to sell an animal outside of the auction, you will be disqualified, forfeit all prizes and auction monies.
- 15. Exhibits for fryer, baker, and roaster will be entered in regular division.
- 16. Maricopa County Dress Code required.
- 17. Removal of show animals prior to the end of fair is prohibited. (Only exceptions that will be made are for health reasons by fair officials)

DIVISION 3750: Meat Pen

It takes approximately 8 weeks to raise a Meat Pen. Entries cannot be more than ten weeks old. All three rabbits should look as much alike as possible. General disqualifications apply in this class. Rabbits must have a permanent tattoo mark. Tattoo must be recorded on the entry form.

Class Description

- Breeds maturing less than 8 lbs: three live rabbits per pen any sex uniform in size. Top weight for each rabbit is 4 lbs.
- 243 Breeds maturing more than 8 lbs: three rabbits per pen any sex uniform in size weighing 3.01 lbs 5 lbs. Top weight for each rabbit is 5 lbs.

DIVISION 3751: Fryer

Class Description

Maximum age 10 weeks ~ maximum weight 5 lbs.

DIVISION 3752: Baker Class Description

Less than 6 mo. old: Minimum weight 5.5 lbs.~ maximum weight 8 lbs.

DIVISION 3753: Roaster Class Description

More than 6 mo. Old: Minimum weight 8 lbs.

DIVISION 3754: Poster Contest - No entry fee

Submit at receiving Tuesday, April 11, 2023. Posters must be created by a 4-H - FFA - Open Youth member who is an exhibitor within the department. The poster contest provides an opportunity to acquaint the public with any phase, or phases of rabbit breeding and production such as, but not limited to: breeding, management and any commodity of food and fiber. Two poster limit.
