Please read and understand all rules before entering this department

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. No entry limit, assuming space is available.
2. **Each entry must be marked on the back with the following: Name, Age, Grade, School/Home Address**
3. Entries must be created by exhibitor after the 2023 Fair.
4. Models and/or kits are not accepted.
5. Mount artwork onto construction paper or poster board with 1" border or less. Entries may be stapled or taped for exhibit. Matting is not necessary.
6. Artwork cannot exceed 16" x 20".
7. Optional: Protect pastels, charcoal, oil pastels, watercolor entries with spray sealant, plastic Mylar sheet or plastic wrap - No Glass.
8. Exhibitors may choose to sell their item(s). Item must be marked for sale on the entry and a sale price included. The fair will retain 10% commission on each item sold. All sales **MUST** go through the fair office – no direct sales allowed.
