Home Arts Exhibitors Please Note: Be sure to indicate the correct division on your entry form. In this department we have Youth: age 5 – 12, Teen: age 13 – 18, Adult: age 19+, and Person(s) with Disabilities. **Be sure to indicate the correct division on your entry.** If the exhibitor is younger than 18 years of age, include your age and your parent signature where indicated. Failure to comply with these rules may result in disqualification of the entry.

Special Rules and Regulations for Home Arts

(See General Rules for further instruction)

1. Unlimited Entries are allowed for all classes unless specified. Premiums are limited to the top 2 per class per exhibitor.
2. No exhibit will be accepted unless there is a division and class listed in the exhibitor handbook. Exhibitors are solely responsible for deciding on the proper division and class for their entry. Entries improperly classified will not be changed or judged. Refunds will not be issued for items incorrectly entered by the exhibitor or for juried out entries.
3. All work must be the handiwork of the exhibitor and have been created within the past two years.
4. Entries will not be accepted, judged, or exhibited if they are stained, soiled or unsanitary. Must be free of pet odor and dog hair.
5. The subject matter for each entry must be appropriate for the family nature of the Fair (no nudity or violence).
6. Entries cannot be double entered. One class per entry.
7. Exhibitor must be an Arizona resident for at least six months of the calendar year.
8. All entries may not be displayed based on variety and space available. Coordinator will make final decision regarding placement.
9. It shall be at the sole discretion of the judges whether the entries are awarded First, Second, Third or Honorable Mention and corresponding premium money. At the discretion of the judges and Coordinator, classes may be combined where closely related, provided an insufficient number of entries in any one class does not provide adequate competition. No division or class may be reopened after the judging is finished.
10. Only the judges' books will be used as evidence for payment of premiums. Ribbons or tags are not accepted as proof of results. Judging is closed to the public and exhibitors.
11. The decision of the judges shall in all cases be final.
12. All entries must be picked up during designated pick-up times. Due to lack of storage, items not picked up by the deadline will be charged a \$25 handling fee and a \$1/day storage fee. Items not collected within 30 days will be donated or removed from the Fair Grounds.
13. All items may only be entered ONE time in the Arizona State Fair.
14. Sewing will be judged by the following guidelines:
 - a. Garment needs to be clean and odor free.
 - b. Gathering threads need to be removed.
 - c. Garments cannot have rips or tears.
 - d. Zippers need to be neatly installed.
 - e. Seams do not need to be serged
15. Thread used should be the same color throughout.
16. Items may be marked for sale on entry form. Prices are not negotiable. The fair will handle the sale and deduct 10%. Money for sold items will be mailed in a separate check from fair premiums within 30 days of the closing of fair.

SPECIAL RULES FOR QUILTS

1. Quilt Sleeve: all entries entered in the Quilt Department must have a 4-inch sleeve basted (sewn) across the entire top edge of the quilt for display purposes. The opening must be 4 inches from seam to seam.

2. Quilts with a sleeve smaller or larger than 4 inches or a sleeve that is not securely attached (sewn) will not be hung. Dowels used for display by the State Fair fit in the 4-inch opening. The State Fair will check all quilts before they are judged for competition to be sure they qualify. Quilts with a wood or other type of dowel included in the sleeve may not be able to be hung.
