May Financial Summary: District funds increased by \$28,676.70 (4%) compared to

last year, with a current bank balance of \$725,496.50.

- **Reconciliation**: No variances between district and county ledgers; diligent reconciliation process explained.
- **Budget Expenditure**: Positive budget balance of \$59,848.07 at end of May; approximately \$100,000 (M&O) and \$20,000 (capital) to roll over.
- **Student Activities**: May saw a \$46.68 deposit; year-over-year increase of \$502.77 (15%).
- **Inventory Report**: FY25 physical inventory completed, with a new spreadsheet system tracking assets and disposals. Several items (e.g., laptops, printers) identified for disposal due to loss or unaccounted status.
- **Process Improvements**: New procedures for asset tracking, regular updates, and board approval calendar established to ensure compliance and transparency.
