Approve Minutes of the August 20, 2020 Conference Call

A motion was made by Cindy Gruwell and seconded by Ricky Lambert to approve the minutes of the August 20, 2020 conference call. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action on the Proposed Year End Rodeo

There was discussion regarding the end of the 2020 season. The idea of having a year-end rodeo was not coming together regarding when and where. A solution would be to only give season leader buckles this year instead of World Champions without any type of year end rodeo or finals. There was concern over the memberships for 2021. Several board members felt it would be better to have a reduced membership for those members who purchased a 2020 card.

Willy Kelton has agreed to hold two full rodeos in conjunction with the Jimbo Wales Memorial Timed Event Rodeo which will be held in February. One or both full rodeos could be a membership rodeo.

A motion was made by Cindy Gruwell and seconded by Ryan Robrahn to end 2020 with a season leader buckle and to make a concession for the 2020 cardholders on their 2021 membership dues. Non 2020 cardholders would have to pay full price. Further, the bull riders will have to pay full price if they hold a finals in their event. Motion passed unanimously.

Curt Johnston asked Mike Atwell for an update on the 501c3 status. Mike said he is working with the IRS but since they are short staffed right now, it is difficult. He will keep Curt updated on the progress and will contact Lanna Mesenbrink if he needs any information.
