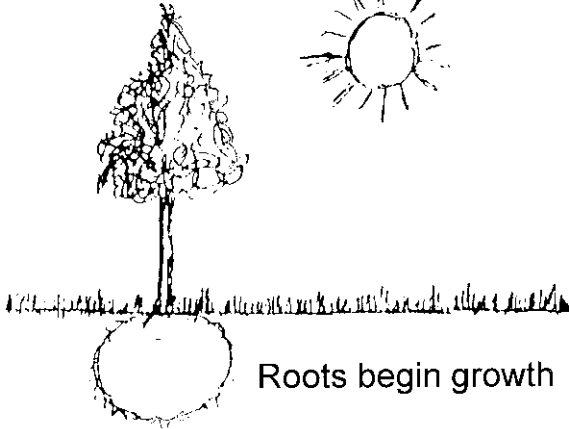


Advantages of Fall Planting

FALL

— Cooling Air

Fall-planted



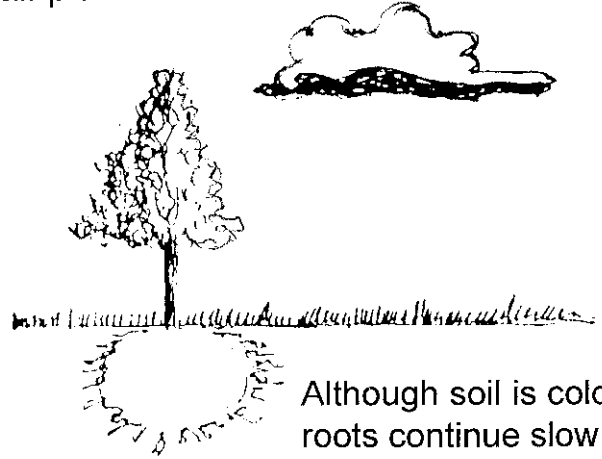
Roots begin growth

Still-warm soil holds heat from summer.

WINTER

— Cold Air & short days, minimal top growth

Fall-planted



Although soil is cold, roots continue slow growth using plant stored food.

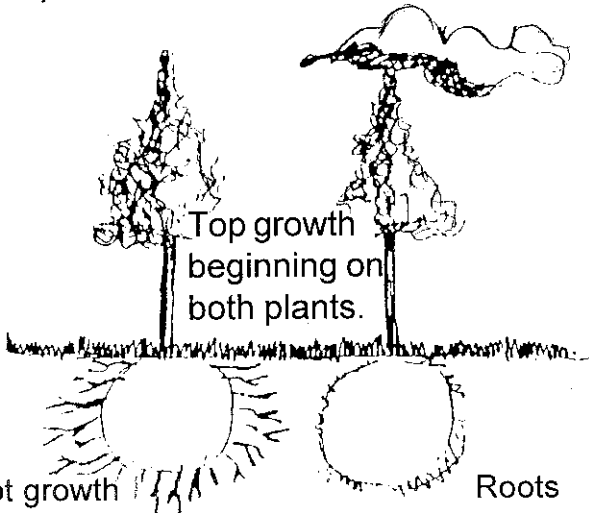
Cold soil with lots of moisture.

EARLY SPRING

— Warming Air

Fall-planted

Spring-planted



Top growth beginning on both plants.

Root growth continues.

Cold Soil

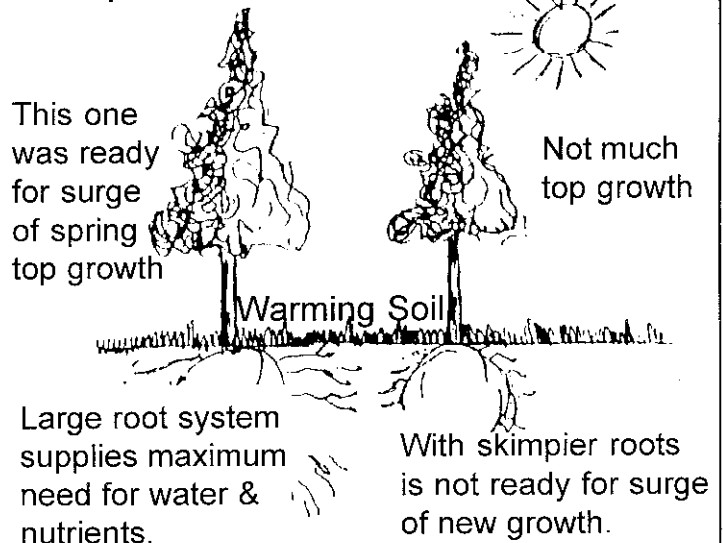
Roots start slowly.

LATE SPRING

— Warm Air & growth surge.

Fall-planted

Spring-planted



This one was ready for surge of spring top growth

Not much top growth

Warming Soil

Large root system supplies maximum need for water & nutrients.

With skimpier roots is not ready for surge of new growth.
