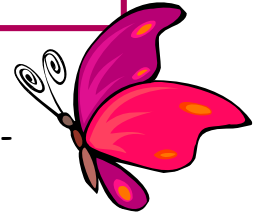




# Butterflies in the Garden

You have to have caterpillars to have butterflies. The little damage they do to plants is well worth the beauty and interest they add to the garden

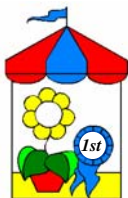
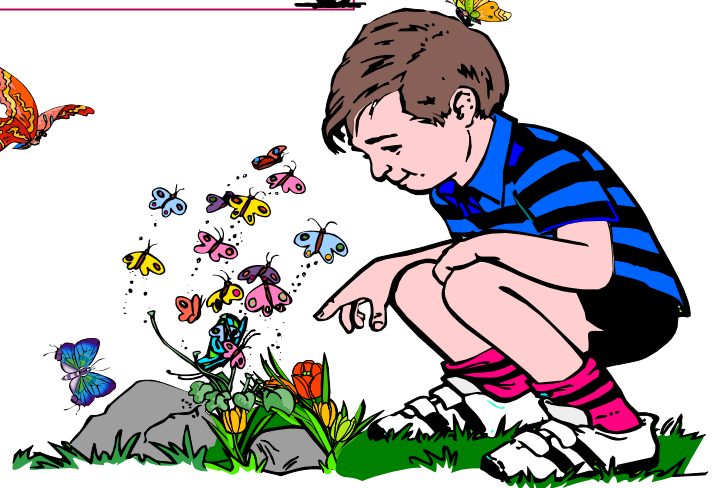
