

TAG Update on Delaware National Guard

Major General James A. Benson Adjutant General, Delaware National Guard Army

Major General James A. Benson assumed the duties of The Adjutant General of Delaware on January 30, 2025. In this role, he is responsible for overseeing the mission readiness of all Delaware National Guard units, including more than 1,500 Soldiers and 1,100 Airmen, ensuring their preparedness for both federal and state missions.

Prior to becoming The Adjutant General, MG Benson served as the Assistant Adjutant General of the Army for the Delaware National Guard from June 2023 to January 2025. He also held the position of Director of the Joint Staff, Delaware National Guard, from January 2021 to June 2023. Throughout his distinguished career, MG Benson has held numerous leadership positions, including command of the 259th (Tropo) Signal Company, the 198th Expeditionary Signal Battalion, and the 261st Theater Tactical Signal Brigade.

MG Benson's military service includes deployments in support of both Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom, where he gained invaluable experience in leading and coordinating complex operations in challenging environments.

A dedicated lifelong learner, MG Benson is a graduate of the University of Delaware, where he earned a Bachelor's degree in Economics. He went on to earn a Master of Business Administration from Wilmington University and a Master of Strategic Studies from the Army War College.

In his civilian career, MG Benson was an Emergency Management Consultant with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and the United States Department of Agriculture, leveraging his military expertise to enhance disaster response and recovery efforts.

MG Benson's breadth of experience and unwavering dedication to both his country and community make him a respected leader within the Delaware National Guard and beyond.
