## SAFETY RULES 2024

RULES COMMITTEE PRESIDENT JAMES GROSSMAN, CHAIRMAN DANIEL QUECK, MEMBERS, BRENT CUMMINS, RYAN HERX AND MILES ANDERSON

- 1 General membership will meet once a year to discuss or change rules. Rules committee has the right to make changes to safety rules if a problem arises.
- 2 All participants must read and comply with the rules governing the tractor pulls and must attend the drivers meeting prior to each pull. SAFETY IS OUR MOTTO!!
3. The rules committee decision is final in all instances.
4. No consumption of alcoholic beverages allowed, automatic DQ.
5. Any puller under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present to pull. They also need to be able to operate the tractor without assistance.
6. Driver must remain seated at all times while pulling with one hand on the steering wheel. NO SEAT BOUNCING AUTOMATIC DQ
7. ANY driver refusing to stop when red flagged WILL BE DQ.
8. Any gas leaks must be fixed before a tractor can pull. And done by the end of the class.
9. Tractor must stay inside boundary lines. If any part of the tractor crosses out of bounds will end your pull. If you stop when flagged you will receive your distance. If the driver refuses to stop he will be disqualified.
10. All pulls must start with a tight chain and no more than half throttle, no popping clutches.
11. If anything falls off your tractor while hooked to the sled it will be an automatic disqualification.
12. Speed limits for Div II will be 3 mph for regular classes and 4 mph for classes the end with 50 (like 3750, 4750, 5250, and 5750). Div III speed limit will be 4 mph, Open classes will be 6 and 12 mph. Speed cone for div II and div III will be 85 ft and open will be 120 ft. Back of the sled will be the measuring point. Blowing the horn pass that point will be a DQ.
13. Full pull distance will be determined at each pull and announced at the drivers meeting.
14. During hooking and unhooking, tractor must be in neutral with the drivers hands raised.
15. Failure to comply with these rules, or tampering with another pullers tractor, or unsportsman like behavior, will disqualify that person from the pull or club.
