

10. ALL TRACTORS must pass a safety/tech inspection prior to pulling. Inspection stickers will be applied and displayed once you pass inspection.

11. All tractors pulling for exhibition purposes only must get permission from the President and must meet all the safety rules. And will pull only at the end of the day.

12. Wheelie bars are mandatory on all Div II, Div III and open class tractors. Wheelie bar must be able to support the weight of the tractor in its heaviest class. Wheelie bar must extend past the radius of the tire and be no more than 10" off the ground. Must have at least a 5" square pad. Wheelie bars will be checked by jacking them up one side at a time. Any cross bars on the wheelie bars must not interfere with the chain.

13. Front weight brackets/weights may not extend more than 11' from center of rear wheel

14. Protest will be made to rules committee members. A protest will result in both the protestors and protested tractors being checked. Burden of proof will rest with the protester on technical rules. Protest must be made before the completion of the next class, and must come from a puller in that class. There will be a \$75 fee for a protest. If the protested tractor fails to meet the rules the protester will get their \$75 back. If the protested tractor passes the \$75 will go to the club. Rules committee members have the authority to protest any tractor at any time on or off the track.
