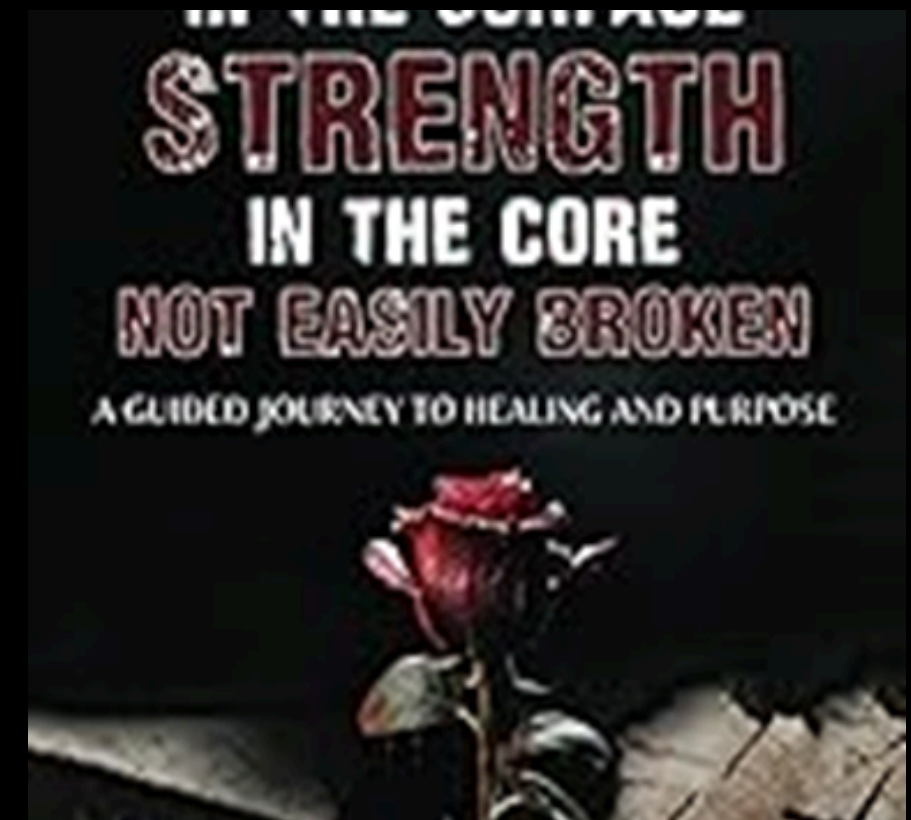

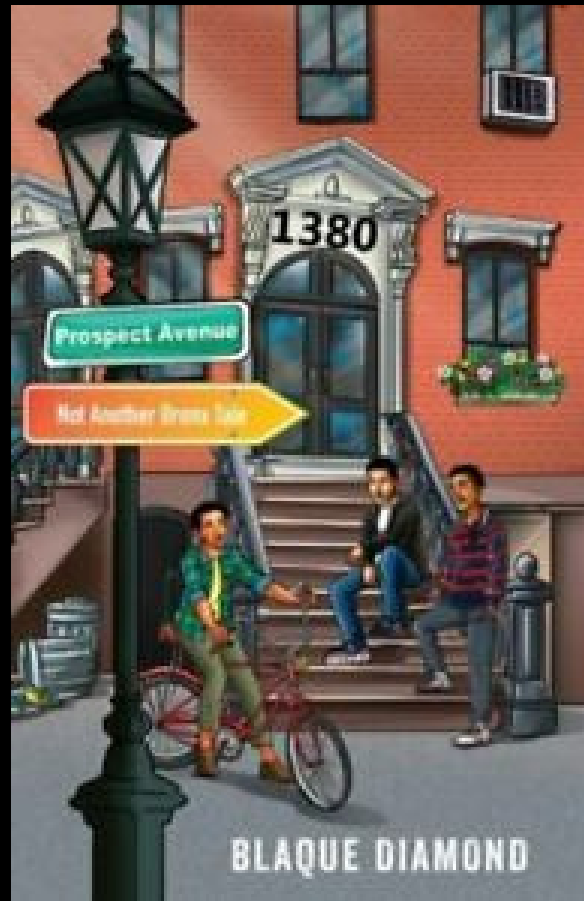

1380 Prospect Avenue: Not Another Bronx Tale



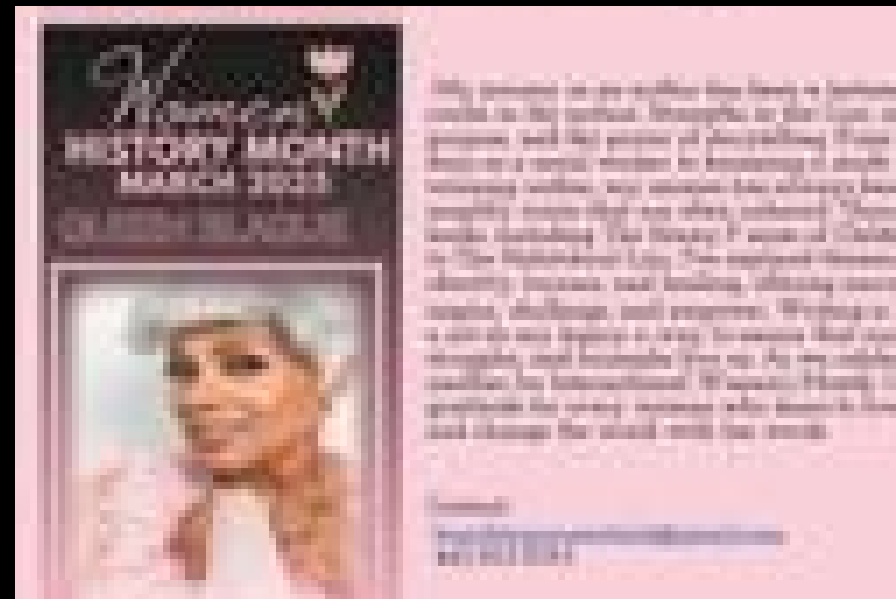
