# Shade Trees

## Oaks



Bur Oak – *Quercus macrocarpa*

80' X 80'

The bur oak is a majestic tree known for its massive size and wide-spreading crown. Bur oaks are slow-growing but long-lived, often reaching several centuries in age. Their most notable characteristic is the large acorn. Bur oaks are also highly adaptable, tolerating a range of soil conditions and drought.

Chinkapin Oak – *Quercus robur*

50' X 50'

The chinkapin oak is a medium-sized oak tree with a rounded to spreading crown. It's known for its relatively fast growth rate for an oak. Chinkapin oaks produce small acorns with a shallow cup, and they are an important food source for wildlife.

Nuttall Oak – *Quercus nuttallii*

80' X 60'

The Nuttall oak is a large deciduous tree prized for its vibrant red fall foliage. It forms a broad, pyramidal crown. This oak has good fall color and is adaptable to various soil conditions. Prefers more neutral to acidic soils but is a more tolerant oak with similar characteristics of a pin oak.

Swamp White Oak – *Quercus bicolor*

# Columnar Trees



**Streetspire Oak – *Quercus robur x alba* 40' X 15'**

Prairiefire Crabapple - Malus spp.

Spring Snow Crabapple - Malus spp.

## Velvet Pillar Crabapple - *Malus* spp.

25' X 15'

They're prized for their profusion of single, deep pink blossoms in spring, creating a vibrant display. Following the flowers, small, dark red crabapples develop, persisting into winter. The foliage emerges a purplish-bronze, maturing to a dark green with reddish undertones in the summer.

## Royal Raindrops Crabapple - *Malus* spp. 20' X 20'

Royal Raindrops crabapples are a stunning ornamental tree prized for their vibrant white-pink flowers, unique purple foliage, and persistent, glossy red fruit. What sets this variety apart is its dark, purplish-red foliage that holds its color throughout the summer, adding a dramatic touch to the landscape. It's also known for its excellent disease resistance, contributing to its popularity as a low-maintenance and visually striking tree.

## Ornamental Pear Tree - *Pyrus calleryana* 30' X 20'

White blooms create a stunning display, often considered one of the first signs of spring. Their upright, often pyramidal shape makes them a good choice for lining streets or as a focal point in the landscape. Very small ornamental pear fruits develop on this tree following the flowers, and create valuable food for wildlife. These trees are often planted in rows along driveways or as specimen trees.

## Hot Wings Maple – *Acer tataricum*

18' X 18'

## Serviceberry – *Amelanchier arborea*

## Chokecherry - *Prunus virginiana*

The Canada Red Chokecherry (*Prunus virginiana* 'Canada Red') is a striking ornamental tree known for its unique foliage transformation. Its leaves emerge bright green in spring, then gradually deepen to a rich, dark purple throughout the summer, providing season-long color. It produces small, reddish-purple berries that ripen to black in late summer. While the raw fruits are astringent, they are popular for making jams, jellies, and pies, and are also a valuable food source for birds.

## Redbud - *Cercis canadensis*

25' X 25'

Redbuds are cherished ornamental trees, particularly for their vibrant magenta or pink blooms that herald the arrival of spring. Their graceful, often multi-stemmed form and heart-shaped leaves provide year-round interest, making them a popular choice for garden beds and naturalized areas. Tolerant of a range of conditions and relatively low-maintenance, redbuds are a reliable and beautiful addition to many landscape designs.

# Evergreen Trees



Taylor Juniper - *Juniperus virginiana* 15' X 4'

Taylor junipers offer significant utility in the landscape due to their distinctive narrow, upright growth habit, making them ideal for tight spaces as vertical accents or screens. Drought-tolerant and adaptable to various soil conditions, they provide a low-maintenance, year-round evergreen presence that enhances garden structure. Their columnar form thrives in diverse climates, contributing to consistent aesthetic appeal without demanding extensive lateral room.

Spartan Juniper - *Juniperus chinensis* 'Spartan' 15' X 5'
