Early Voting Begins Next Month on September 19!

"Virginia is one election away from becoming California!"

That was the warning we heard from Winsome Sears' campaign representative at March's MCRC monthly meeting. The date for the General Election for deciding the next Governor of Virginia is Tuesday, November 4, 2025.

While we may yearn for an election day with paper ballots that are counted, without delay, all across the USA, until changes are made to the election rules, we have to use the current rules to our advantage. Waiting to vote on Election Day may introduce unforeseen complications. What if your car won't start? What if there is severe weather, downing trees and cutting power?

It is the duty of Every Good Republican of Middlesex County to go the Registrar's Office at 105 Bowden Street in Saluda beginning on September 19 to cast their vote in person before election day. Early in person voting continues through November 1.

Casting you vote early helps Republican Party of Virginia redirect financial and personnel support to those precincts most in need.

Last year, Rob Wittman pleaded with all present during his remarks at Pork and Politics to **VOTE EARLY!** He asked us to make a list of 20 people and to call them to remind them that early voting in-person voting begins September 19. Then, each week, check back to make sure that person has voted, and if not, how can you assist them on getting to the registrar's office to vote. We need to execute this plan again to **GET OUT THE VOTE** and ensure Winsome Sears is elected as the first black female Governor of Virginia in November.

New for 2025: Republican Party Embraces Permanent Absentee Ballots

Winsome's campaign representative also asked Middlesex Republicans to go a step beyond early voting and to consider requesting permanent absentee ballots. Democrats have mastered the use of absentee ballots and Republican leaders are asking us to counter Democrat efforts with our own initiatives. Scott Pressler has been promoting absentee ballot applications for months in Pennsylvania.

The process for requesting a permanent absentee ballot is simple and can be done online or by submitting a paper application. The site is very easy to use. The entire process takes less than five minutes.

To apply online, make sure you have your Virginia driver's license and social security number handy, then go to: https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation

When the first screen comes up, select "Apply to Vote Absentee by Mail". Alternatively, a paper application can be printed, filled out and mailed to: Director of Elections, Middlesex County, P.O. Box 358, Saluda, VA 23149

Don't Let Abigail Spanberger Ruin Virginia's Economy!

Spanberger says she wants to "Lower costs for Virginia's families". She has no plan to accomplish this. Lowering the cost of energy would help families, but a look at her voting record on energy issues shows her supporting policies that raise the cost of energy, thus raising cost for families.

Here is a small sample of her votes on energy issues:

- Voted for the deceptively named Inflation Reduction Act, with unprecedented \$783 Billion in radical climate handouts
- Voted NO on "Save Our Gas Stoves Act"
- Voted NO on "Hands Off Our Home Appliances Act", a government crackdown on all gas appliances
- Opposed boosting domestic natural gas exports and infrastructure
- Supports Government-controlled thermostats wants your power company to decide when your AC stays on or shuts off.

Do not be fooled by Spanberger's hand-wringing about the "massive" layoffs in the Federal work-force. Many Federal workers have opted for early retirement or taken a voluntary buyout. Despite this long overdue reduction in the Federal workforce, Arlington and Alexandria are actually experiencing regional job growth.

Job opportunities in Virginia are expected to continue to expand. Overall, employment in Virginia is projected to grow 10.1 percent by 2026, exceeding the national growth rate of 7.4 % (Source: virginiaworks.com).

Last year at Pork and Politics, Winsome Sears told us that Democrats are **extreme** and their positions **make no sense**. She said that voting for the Republican ticket (Trump and Vance) was not a vote for the lesser of two evils, but rather a vote for a lessening of evil. She touted the Youngkin administration successes in attracting new businesses to Virginia and she will continue to work to make Virginia #1 for business in the U.S.
