<b>Cannabinoid Potency</b> 3 g (Dried Flower)/ 1 ml (oil/extract)	<b>CAD \$160</b>	Quantification of 9 cannabinoids including THC-A, Δ-9-THC, CBD, CBD-A, d8-THC etc. Please contact us for more details.
<b>Pesticides</b> 3 g (Dried Flower)/ 2 ml (oil/extract)	<b>CAD \$320</b>	Chemical residue testing in line with Health Canada mandates for 22 pesticides.
<b>Terpenes</b> 10 g (Dried Flower)/ 1 ml (oil/extract)	<b>CAD \$120</b>	Tests and quantifies 40* different terpenes, including Myrcene, Limonene, Caryophyllene and others (*more to come)
<b>Microbiology</b> 40 g (Dried Flower)/ 40 ml (oil/extract)	<b>CAD \$145</b>	Screening for standard microbiological impurities.
<b>Complete Cannabis Testing</b> 60 g (Dried Flower)/ 60 ml (oil/extract)	<b>CAD \$1200</b>	Cannabinoid & terpene profiling, pesticide screening, moisture content & microbiology
