# For Arts-Focused Organizations and Institutions

Ragliacci may be a resource for your students, clients, or staff to further develop their professional skills, explore collaboration, and to strategize approaches to presentation and performance.

## For Non-Profits, Cooperative, Educational, or Corporate Settings

Ragliacci may best serve your organization as a creative facilitator for meetings and events. We are available for presentations, workshops, skills development, and exploring intersectionality.

## Theatre Making

Ragliacci is able to provide support as well as instruction in acting, directing, and musical capacities with a focus on interactivity and audience engagement. They are able to lead text analysis workshops, monologue/scene work, and basic devising strategies for creative writing and abstract generation. They can facilitate storytelling in several forms with a focus on collaboration and freedom of expression. These elements benefit organizations who create content, want to explore group dynamics, and inspire participants to cultivate a mutual understanding and voicing of their experiences. Work may be internal with the option for public-facing performance.

## Music

Ragliacci is able to provide 1:1 or group instruction and/or direction in relation to employing music as a tool of generative expression. This may manifest as studio-style lessons in voice, guitar, basic keyboard, and/or hand percussion. It may present as leading a group singing experience or event program offering. It may be employed as a tool for participants to share their own work supported by accompaniment, underscoring, and/or live production. We may also explore music through the intersections between culture, history, society, and technology to understand why it is and what it does in relation to human environments.

#### Clowning

This offering investigates a practice of being vulnerable and open from an intuitive place within the individual and how it may engage others in daily practice and/or performance. It is a multidisciplinary approach to developing a sense of honesty and trust, especially in being able to share global observations or personal truths. It inhabits the body much more than the cerebral mind, also using humor evident in the everyday to jostle and learn. Clowning may reveal creative strategies to problem-solving. It may continue development of non-verbal techniques to facilitate connection. It may create space for shareable catharsis and expand supportive feedback systems. It may demonstrate efficacy in exploring power structures and potential transformations thereof.

## Empathy and Communication

Ragliacci is able to use and/or share skills in motivational interviewing, reflexive listening, and empathic training most often employed to work with participants who work in sensitive public-facing contexts such as clinical settings or conflict resolution. This could be useful in human resource skills development, or as an opportunity to roleplay presentational content. It also has efficacy in transformative justice, mediation, and direct action contexts.

### Divination

Ragliacci creates interrogative storytelling experiences based on the traditions of tarot cards and runes to conduct intuitive dialogue with individuals, couples, and small groups. [See attached]
