# FWC Addressed the Target Shooting Issue in the ECWMA & They Want You To Comment

FWC is working to end the target shooting happening out in the ECWMA that is causing safety concerns and destruction of the property.

House Bill 45 was introduced and passed with intention of unifying gun regulations and prohibiting any county, city, town or municipal ordinances from enforcing stronger gun regulations than the rest of the state.

All existing rules related to the use of firearms that are not associated with hunting/shooting ranges had to be adjusted or removed to be compliant with House Bill 45. This included the removal of FWC's general rule prohibiting target shooting and test firing on WMA's.

According to FL Statute 790.15 the discharge of a firearm is prohibited, except in public places open for hunting. While it is never recommended, it is also not expressly prohibited; therefore leaving law

enforcement with little to no ability to restrict the target shooters.

FWC is proposing a rule change to close all of the levees, parking areas, boat



ramps, power pads, and access roads associated with the levees for hunting, which would then make target shooting prohibited.

### **Hunting without a Quota Permit**

Did you know there are WMA's that you can hunt without a quota permit? These areas can be hunted during Archery, Muzzleloader, and General Gun Seasons.

# The Curbelo-Moulton Bill (H.R. 3999) and what you should know about it.

In the wake of the Las Vegas tragedy, a bill has been introduced to "ban the manufacture, sale and use of bump stocks" This bill is being structured in what is referred to as "Noah's Ark" style meaning members would have to have a co-sponsor from the opposing party. There are currently 20 pairs of co-sponsors in support of this bill.

According to the Organization, The Three Percenters, (*Thethreepercenters.org*) The vague wording on this bill could indirectly implement a blanket ban on nearly every semi-automatic rifle system in existence. The majority of factory and aftermarket components available for semiautomatic rifle platforms are designed to improve the performance of the rifle, allowing the shooter to more effectively place rounds on the target in a shorter time span (which would increase the rate of fire).

Possession of virtually all magazines, aftermarket triggers, buffers, buffer springs and a variety of other components could be immediately rendered illegal. After the 90 day amnesty period, nearly every owner of a semiautomatic rifle with a magazine would be immediately classified as a criminal.

### Airboater's Code of Ethics

- 1. I will respect the rights of all users of the recreational waterways of the State of Florida, on public waters and on adjacent private property.
- 2. I will be considerate and courteous at public vessel launch ramps and docks. In an effort not to disturb other boaters, I will launch and retrieve my vessel promptly.
- 3. I will always operate at a safe speed in posted "No Wake" zones.
- 4. When approaching the shoreline, I will be especially aware of swimmers and other water vessels near the shoreline.
- 5. I realize that my vessel's equipment, ability, weather conditions, and especially other vessel traffic should determine my vessel speed.
- 6. In case of an emergency, I will volunteer assistance.
- 7. I am aware that my vessel creates air propeller wash and will use idle speed near the shoreline and in the close proximity to boat ramps.
- 8. I will ensure that all passengers in my vessel are equipped with safety equipment, including life vests and required safety equipment.
- 9. I will avoid unnecessary disturbance of wildlife and will not enter posted "No Trespass" areas.
- 10. I will pay close attention to the engine sound levels that my vessel may create and be aware of how others on the shoreline will react to it.
- 11. I will not litter and will bring back all trash. I will be careful in handling my fuel.
- 12. I will not interfere with or harass others. I realize that people will judge all airboaters by my individual actions.
