### President's Letter

Here we are in October the 10<sup>th</sup> Month of 2019. Wednesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> was our last general membership meeting of the year before we go dark. In just over 60 days it will be 2020. There is some things that have just happened, and some things coming up I want to report to you. First, we had our Memorial Run last and I was very pleased with the turnout. There were just shy of 30 boats who participated. The really good news, there were a lot of new people who showed up to support our club. We took paid applications for membership from 4 airboaters. This is a new trend as every month we are receiving new applications and some applications from previous members who are coming back. This is very encouraging. I want to thank Jennifer Green, our Secretary for her diligence in sending out notices to present and past members, and our members handing out membership applications to potential members. It is paying off.

There is no secret our club has been spending more money than it was taking in. The Executive Board and General Membership have come together to address and correct our financial concerns. A Financial Committee has been established and Jason Freeman is the Chairman. All expenses are being scrutinized and events are budgeted. In this process there are changes being made. If you attended our Awards Banquet, you would have seen a very distinct format. Previously, this event that would cost approximately \$4,000 in expense to the Club; but this year with raffles, more accurate ticket pricing, and a reduction in the cost of awards, the Club actually made \$4,000.

Our last event was the Memorial Run. This event has historically cost the Club \$400, this time we took in \$578, and with expenses deducted we will have made about \$425.

The Istapoga Youth Hunt has historically been our most expensive hunt of the year. It is the furthest hunt location from Broward and required a motor home to house the volunteers and tow trailers. With the budget of this hunt cut by 66%, it is still happening. I have seen footage from the game cameras, and there is a good chance the youth will harvest some good deer and/or hogs.

In the past two years we have had 3 attendees to the Everglades Youth Conservation Camp fail to attend. We were only told of one camper who could not make it in time, and we were able to salvage that cost. The club lost \$720 because of the other two. The entire process of having a child attend is being re-evaluated. If you receive any correspondence from EYCC in January, make sure you check with our Treasurer Bill Sirola before registering your child. The new process will have to be followed to get a scholarship for your child.

There are many rumors circulating about changes that could be made to our Southeastern and Western Everglades. Your BCAHCC, Dade County Fulltrack Club, and the Everglades Coordinating Council (ECC) are all paying attention to any changes. If anyone ever asks you, "Why should I join a club?" you can say because they fight for your right to access the Everglades. Two of your Executive Board Members were part of a coalition who met at the Two Story Camp at the end of the Microwave Canal. We heard the top officials discuss what they knew about the West Everglades Restoration Project. This project is currently dead; however, there are some things that would benefit our Club Members.

There was a plan submitted for everyone's review called the H Plan (H for Hail Mary). It was submitted by the Hydrologist Truman "Gene" Duncan from the Miccosukee Indians. He has been at his job for 31 years. He explained how the most amount of good could be salvaged from the W.E.R.P. Project. Many attending were impressed and we spent time talking with the invited attendees about the possibility of reviving certain parts. I had the representative from the Department of Interior (DOI) Adam Gelver on my boat and I was very pleased with how he felt and what he said. There is a spirit of cooperation among the Seven Organizations, Senator Scott, District 106 Representative and Army Corp of Engineer, Colonel Polk. Stay tuned you will know what I know, when I find out. Thank you Mike Elfenbein for making it happen.

The last thing I want to mention is the <u>Ghosts and Goblin Run</u> Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, yes, I know it is after Halloween, but who cares, you or the kids can wear their costumes one more time. There will be 5 prizes awarded for best costumes. Come on out, have some fun, good food and fellowship with Club Members and guests. I want to specifically thank Pete Hora, Jennifer Green, Dan and Sherry Cimas, Bill Lewis, Kevin Fitzgerald and all of the people who help put up the Everglades Shade, and who make these events fun for everyone. The kids really benefit from your efforts. Hope to see everyone soon and hoping you and your families are in good health and ready for the Holiday Season.
