

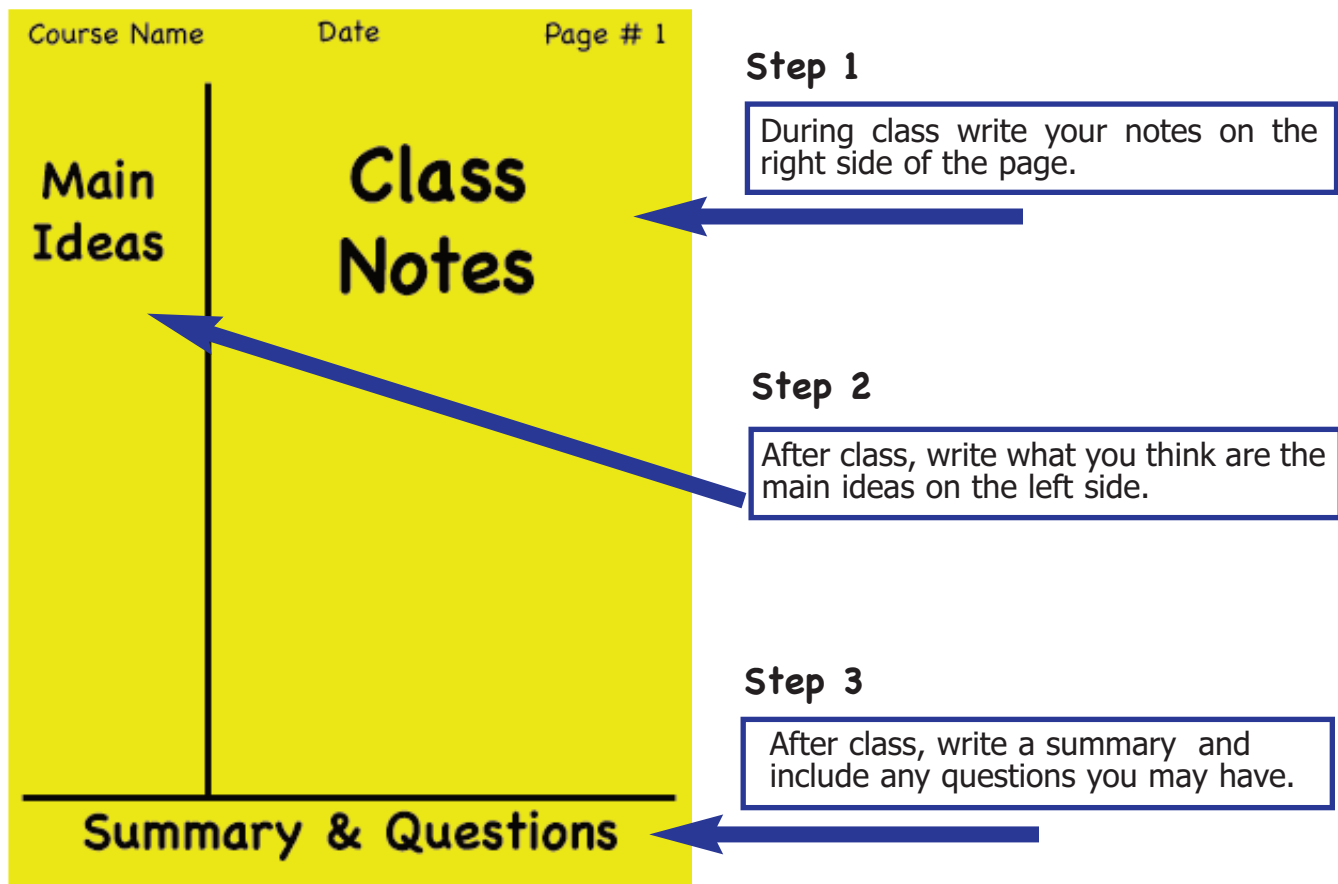
Chapter 12 Note-Taking Skills
