Multiple System Atrophy (MSA), Progressive Supranuclear Palsy (PSP), Corticobasal Degeneration (CBD) and Lewy Body Dementia (LBD).

MSA is a progressive neurological disorder, affecting mobility, balance and autonomic function.

PSP is a progressive neurological disorder, impairment of movement, vision, speech and swallowing.

CBD is a progressive, neurological disorder with impairments in cognition and executive function with upper limb dysfunction and other Parkinson's features

Lewy Body Dementia is a progressive condition, causing impairments in, spatial awareness and executive function alongside motor features of Parkinson's.
