The following recommendations should be executed to assure your safety, comfort and continued enjoyment.

- 1. WARNING: Your new stove may have sharp corners, be sure to handle stove with care.
- 2. Before you start any fire in your stove, be sure the stove is assembled correctly.
- 3. Burn your new stove with pipe attached, outdoors for at least 1 hour before first use in any enclosed area to assure any residue or galvanized coating is removed.
- 4. Stove is designed for seasonal use. (One month out of the year)
- 5. Never use your stove in any permanent structure, such as your home or residence.
- 6. Please remember all surfaces of your stove will be hot at all times, and may emit sparks out the door or up the flue.
- 7. Keep all flammable material at a safe distance.
- 8. Never build an excessive fire or use firewood full of pitch, this can turn the stove cherry red, which will warp your stove.
- 9. Not intended for use by children under 14 years of age.
- 10. Your tent must include a US Military stove jack, or flame retardant Kevlar equal, where your flue pipe exits the tent. Your stove jack must be located where the stove can have at least 24" clearance from all sides of the stove to all walls of the tent. Any other application could cause your tent to catch fire.
