Hebrews 6:19-20 is a the top, because **hope** is what anchors us and where everything begins; **Ephesians 6:10-18** is on the head of the anchor, because the ultimate outcome of our vision is to drop anchor into the whole **armor** of God; **2 Corinthians 5:7** graces the stem, because **faith** is how we drop anchor in being able to wear the armor; and **Proverbs 4:7** is on the rope, because **wisdom** is what ties faith and hope to the armor!
