Key points to this T-Time:

- We talked about God being kind to the unthankful and evil. When we love our enemies God's way, we are demonstrating His love. As we demonstrate God's love to the unthankful and evil, we draw them into His presence, just as He drew us into His presence with His love when we were unthankful and evil!
- Our final action, to be merciful, sums up this entire T!
- Even though our heart may not be in obeying what we are told to do in this T, when we do obey, we find that our heart will catch up. Obedience transforms our heart!
