The visual image God gave me to go with this phrase was from the old westerns where one person would be riding on the horse and the other person was walking behind with a rope attached to them. If the person walking became weary or just couldn't keep up, they would fall down. If the person on the horse kept going, they would end up dragging the person behind them to death! Literally! Takeaway: Learn how to wait on others by being patient when they are weary or cannot keep up! Things look much different along the journey when you're the one riding the horse!
